# 1. Overview

*The Business Intelligence tables module provides a means to generate lists of data in tabular format with a choice of which columns of data are included.*

*The tables module is particular suited to situations where you require to generate a list of data from within Oceanfile.*

*The tables module provides a number of options including whether data is shown in full or truncated to fit within the column width.*

*The design of the tables templates are saved to a library that provides quick and easy access to load any existing table layout.*

*Tables may be exported to Excel, PDF and Word.*

*Data may be filtered to select date ranges, particular vessels, inspections, chapters, inspectors, inspecting companies, officers and management.*

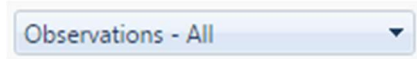

You can filter the observations – there is a set of pre-defined filters, as well as use the advanced filter to create additional filters that may be useful. Select columns that will take part in the assessment and choose types of Observations that the user wants to view. This section describes in detail all the options and how to use the tool.

In “Observations and Non-Conformities” Tab all Observations available for all the Inspections are available. Please remember that amount of information here provided is dependent on the amount of Inspections provided. Please refer either to Getting Started document or Inspection Area of the Help System for more information about setting the Inspections.

There are various options of filtering the information. From the top of the screen on the left there is:

Observations Filter

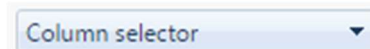


This Filter is presented in a form of Dropdown List. As default it is set to “All”. Other options available are:

- Observations All
- Observations High Risk
- Observations Close Outs Dates
- Observations Grouped by Vessel
- Observations Grouped by Inspector, and
- Observations Grouped by Superintendent

Depending on which of this options is chosen, the Filter will narrow down the list of visible Observations.

Columns Selector



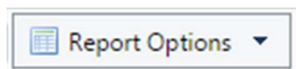
This Filter is presented in a form of Dropdown List. As default, all of the columns are visible on the Index. When the Dropdown List is opened, there is a check box, next to the name of every column, unchecking the box, will cause that the chosen Column will be taken out from the Index. Options available are as follows:

- Reference
- Question
- Observations
- Initial Response
- Subsequent Response
- Vessel
- Inspection Date
- Assessed Risk
- Target Closeout
- Actual Closeout
- Responsibility
- Inspecting Company, and
- Inspector

If any of the columns will get unchecked, the Column Selector will indicate how many Columns are actually selected.



Report Options



This option relates to the View of the Index Page seen. Options visible are as follows:

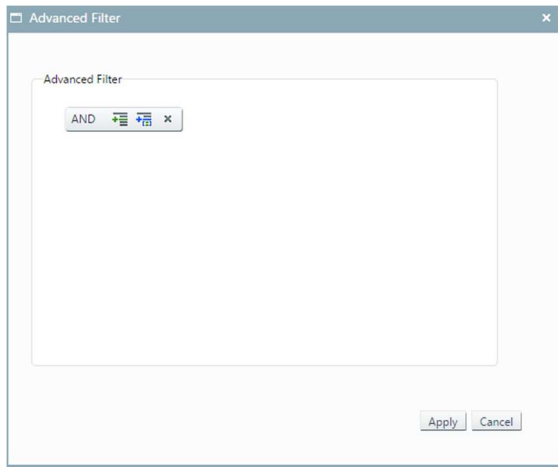


- "Expand/ Truncate Text" - this option will hide/ expand or truncate long text entries.
- "Show/ Hide Grouping" – this option will hide/ open the Grouping Area
- "Show/ Hide Filter Panel" – this option will hide/ open the Filter Panel


### Advanced Filter



This option allows to input Custom Filter Option. To do so click on the "Advanced Filter", which will open the following window:
