
The inspector manager provides the means to view information about inspectors and their inspection and observation history.



The history pop up includes each VIQ question number, vessel name, date of inspection, port, inspecting company, question text and observation.

The inspector's observation history may be exported by clicking on the *Export* button on the toolbar.

The export function supports export to Excel, PDF and Word document formats.

An inspector's profile information may be edited by clicking the *Edit* icon in the second column of the inspector listing

An existing inspector may be deleted by clicking the *Delete* icon in the third column of the inspector listing.
